



## Sticky mushroom and sausage sandwich

Serves: 6

1 /4cup orange marmalade  
2 tbs olive oil  
2 tbs soy sauce  
300g cup mushrooms, sliced  
6 thick sausages  
6 hotdog buns, split  
lettuce leaves, sliced  
cucumber, barbecue sauce  
and potato crisps, to serve

1. Combine marmalade, olive oil and soy sauce in a ceramic dish. Mix well. Add mushrooms, stir to combine. Cover and refrigerate 1 hour.
2. Preheat barbecue plate on high until hot. Reduce heat to medium. Cook sausages for 8 minutes, turning often or until cooked through. Transfer to a plate. Cover to keep warm. Add mushrooms, cook for 4 minutes or until tender.
3. To serve, Split the sausage down the centre, making sure you don't cut all the way through. Top base of the buns with lettuce, cucumber and sausage. Fill sausage with mushrooms. Drizzle with barbecue sauce and serve with potato crisps.
